TECHNICAL DRILL JUDGE A

The Technical Drill Judge A will judge the Leader and Team members for **the number of marchers, the number of marchers incorrectly positioned,** aspects of leg and foot action, posture, arm swing, halts, turns, moving to stand at ease and attention, spacing and salute throughout the Review and Inspection phase of the Technical Drills. This judge shall also judge tempo throughout the Review and Inspection phase. The criteria defining all these aspects are detailed in the Policies & Operations Manual (Technical).

Judging will commence on completion of the music command "BY THE CENTRE – QUICK MARCH" and will cease on completion of the Inspection check as detailed below.

Teams will be judged on their performance of **incorrect drills during each movement**.

During the Inspection a deduction will be given for the incorrectness of each marchers' individual Position of Attention.

Please refer to page 3 of the General Requirements for judging details on "Marking Score Sheets (Technical Judges).

Mobile Position Under 13: 17.08m (28) from Front Boundary, 3.66m (6) Right of Centre = Starting Position Under 18: 16.32m (24) from Front Boundary, 4.08m (6) Right of Centre = Starting Position Senior: 9.00m (12) from Front Boundary, 4.50m (6) Right of Centre = Starting Position

As the Leader begins her nine paces before giving the command "On Parade", the judge will start to move backward cautiously, whilst still judging, until reaching the finishing position.

Under 13: 10.98m (18) from Front Boundary, 3.66m (6) Right of Centre = Finishing Position Under 18: 9.52m (14) from Front Boundary, 4.08m (6) Right of Centre = Finishing Position Senior: 1.50m (2) from Front Boundary, 4.50m (6) Right of Centre = Finishing Position

General

- 1. All aspects executed by team members must be uniform, unless otherwise stated.
- 2. While observing the team member's performance, the number of incorrect aspects will be marked in the headings.
- 3. If a team/member executes a variation of drills within a movement then a deduction of 25 points will be taken under the heading 'Com' (Compliance). The Judge will make an appropriate comment on the back of the sheet explaining why a deduction has been applied.

Score Sheet Headings

All aspects will be judged as per Section 2 Drills and Drills for Review & Inspection, Drills for Quickstep/Compliments/Movements in the Policy and Operations Manual (Technical).

Disc:

When the Review & Inspection finish disc is **not** obtained by the Leader (any part of the correct foot on the disc) there will be **a deduction** of 2 points given, as defined in the Policy & Operations Manual (Technical) under the Review and Inspection of each grade.

Discipline/Error:

Discipline - Talking or counting aloud during any phase of the competition is not permissible. The judge will penalise the team as detailed under "Discipline" of the Policy & Operations Manual (Technical) – General – Section 1.

Error - Deductions will be made for any marcher error throughout the Review & Inspection and the judge will record errors on their sheet accordingly.

Inspection:

Under 13, Under 18, Senior

Immediately following the final salute, the Judge will commence the Inspection of Marchers. The track taken shall be as per the diagram. The Judge will mark each incorrect element with a stroke in the appropriate box. After the inspection has been completed the Judge will then move quickly back to the front of the Team asking the Leader to proceed to the Technical Start Disc.



Comments

It is encouraged that judges complete the 'areas of improvement' section on the back of the sheet. This may assist both the Judge and the Coach during the post-contest interview.

While Coaches will still need to know what aspects require attention, positive comments are encouraged for drills executed correctly.
